Welcome back after Spring Break. **Here are some notes for this week:**

★ Reminders:

- We have chapel every Monday. The 4th quarter missions will help Martin Luther College.
- **Field Trip to Lakeside Lutheran High school is this week Wednesday, March 26th. Please remember to pack your student a cold lunch on that day.**
- We will be singing next as Children's Choir in both services on Palm Sunday, April 13.
- Wednesday, March 26, St. Stephen's will have worship services at 3:45 and 6:30. Please consider joining us for worship as we walk with Christ to the cross of forgiveness. There will be meals between services starting at 4:45. This week the Ladies' Aid will be serving the meal.
- The 2025 Spelling Bee will be held on Friday, March 28 starting at 2:00 in the afternoon. The top 11 spellers from grades 5-8 will participate in this bee.
- This year St. Stephen's will once again host a book fair. We are working with a different group. Instead of Scholastic, we will be hosting an I 55 Book Fair. 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- In order to make the book fair run smoothly, we are looking for parent volunteers to help each day. The fair will run from April 7-13. On Saturday, it will be open after the Fun Run from 11 to Noon. On Sunday, it will run after the second service until noon.
