This week, we will study Holy Week more in depth. The kids have been waiting patiently to hear the rest of the passion account, as we have been working our way through it in Bible time. We will have centers themed for each significant day of Holy Week, to give the children more information about all that their Savior did for them. We will read lessons, sing songs, play review games, work on art projects, and even taste-test foods. Each child will create a project to help them retell Jesus' entire passion account too.

**High Frequency Words** ~ Every week or two, you should receive an updated word list to work on at home. Please review the circled words with your child more than just once. Once a day would be preferred, to help them learn them faster. We have almost worked through all 100 words, so our goal now is to get the kids to know as many words as possible, by heart. At the end, we will also throw in number and color words. Learning these words will help their reading fluency and comprehension, since they will be able to read the words more quickly without sounding them out. Most words follow a code/pattern that your child has learned too, so remind them of that! Thanks for your work.

- Good Friday Midday, April 18 ~ 1:30pm
- Good Friday, Service of Darkness, April 18 ~ 7:00pm (different service from 1:30)

Easter Sunday Worship times are as follows:

- Easter Festival Worship, April 20 ~ 6:30am & 10:00am\* (Kids sing at 8 or 10) - Easter Worship, April 20 ~ 8:00am\* (Communion service) (Kids sing at 8 or 10)

\*On Easter, the 6:30 + 10 AM festival services are the same; 8 AM is a different service. St. Stephen's senior choir also sings at 8 and 10 o'clock services.

There will be Easter Breakfast served between 7:30am and 10:00am, and everyone is welcome to attend. The breakfast will be held in the church basement of St. Stephen's Church.
